1. **Financial Report**

2. **RF Walsh**
 - Bio Square update: Building D will be complete in early winter; Building F not yet planned; NBCL parking lot will hold ~1400 cars for employees, 9 levels of parking, 8 story building; construction will begin next month and take ~ 13 months to complete.
